Welcome to Year 3!

I hope you have all had a fantastic Summer and are looking forward to a year of exciting and challenging learning opportunities. Here is some information you might find useful as we begin our Year 3 journey:

PE lessons will take place on Mondays and Thursday afternoons. The children will need full indoor and outdoor kit for these lessons.

Homework will be sent out every **Friday** (excluding holidays) and needs to be returned by the following Thursday. Each week, homework will consist of one piece of Maths, one piece of English, spellings and times tables for the children to learn. Homework is designed to consolidate what the children have been learning that week. Spellings and times table facts will be tested every Thursday. We also ask that the children read for at least 15 - 20 minutes every night of the school week. This is important to ensure they reach their full potential in English but also filters into other areas of their learning. Stamps are available for those children who read and record what they have read in their reading diary. The children can then win prizes through our reading challenge once they have collected enough stamps.

Our **Topic** for the first half of the Autumn term will be 'Scrumdiddlyumptious'. We will be having a book focus of *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* by Roald Dahl and the children will be using some ideas from the text to produce their own pieces of writing.

Trips and workshops will be planned in advance, giving you plenty of notice for costings and details.
