The Government is providing funding to all primary schools for academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15. The aim of the funding is to enhance current provision in Physical Education.

This funding has enabled us to subscribe to an interactive resource called 'Cyber Coach'. This is being incorporated throughout school for the children as part of their P.E. lesson, during wet outdoor breaks and lunchtimes or as a short 'wake up' in classrooms. We have also made this website a home link for parents and their children to use at their leisure. This funding will also enable us to attend training and P.E. conferences, have specialist trainers to come into school and for a partnership programme of sporting activities to be developed. This will not only provide excellent pupil provision but also significant subject knowledge and professional development for staff.

The funding will be used to enhance and develop the outdoor environment for more adventurous activity. Also to develop the quality and effectiveness of lunchtimes and increased activity levels.
