Sports clubs during lunch-time and after-school	£4650.00	Uptake in sports significantly increased. Prior to use of sport coaches, no clubs took place at lunch-time or after school. More children are playing sports at lunch-time when no club is taking place; evidence that the pupils enjoy the activities and are keen to continue in their own time.
Hall storage equipment, including: mat trolley, small equipment store	£2300.00	Significant improvement in the efficient and safe organisation of all equipment, in particular large gym mats.
CPD : teachers attend 10+ sessions areas for development	£1100.00	Improvement in teacher's knowledge to enable sustainability of sports teaching.
Hire of mini-buses to attend South Staffs Schools' Sports events, including: cross-country, Tri-golf, Life-changing-tennis.	£650 approx	St Paul's now actively participate in all the South Staffs School Sports events, including: Tennis, Tri-golf, athletics, cross-country. There is a large take-up by pupils who demonstrate the skills taught during lessons and in clubs. Until 2015-16, the school had very rarely taken part in these activities as there was limited interest by pupils.
