| Sports clubs during lunch-time and after-school | £4928 | Uptake in sports significantly increased. Prior to use of sport coaches, no clubs took place at lunch-time or after school. | CPD : teachers attend 10+ sessions areas for development | £1500 | Improvement in teacher's knowledge to enable sustainability of sports teaching. |
| Hire of mini-buses to attend South Staffs Schools' Sports events, including: cross-country, Tri-golf, Life-changing-tennis. | £650 | St Paul's now actively participate in all the South Staffs School Sports events, including: Tennis, Tri-golf, athletics, cross-country.
