CPD: Sports coaches to work alongside class teachers to upskill teachers	£7,600	Improvement in teacher's knowledge to enable sustainability of sports teaching.
Lunchtime Sports Clubs Training children to become play leaders	£2280	Uptake in sports significantly increased. Prior to use of sport coaches, no clubs took place at lunch-time or after school. More children are playing sports at lunch-time when no club is taking place; evidence that the pupils enjoy the activities and are keen to continue in their own time.
Sports clubs after-school	£2280	Uptake in sports significantly increased. Children are being introduced to new sports; evidence that the pupils enjoy the activities and are keen to continue in their own time.
Purchase of lunchtime sports equipment	£1000	Evidence of pupil enjoyment. Less accidents and behaviour incidents at lunchtime.
CPD : PE lead attended Level 5 and Level 6 PE awards, SCC training	£2100	Improvement in PE Lead's knowledge to enable sustainability of sports teaching and further support staff.
Hire of mini-buses to attend South Staffs Schools' Sports events, including: cross-country, Tri-golf, Life-changing-tennis.	£250	St Paul's now actively participate in all the South Staffs School Sports events, including: Tennis, Tri-golf, athletics, cross-country. There is a large take-up by pupils who demonstrate the skills taught during lessons and in clubs.
